Complaints to the BBC: April 2012

The BBC answered just over **15,300** complaints from the audience in April 2012. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

This included complaints regarding the two part instalment of *Silent Witness* called Redhill, which some viewers felt contained some violent scenes that were too graphic.
