Complaints to the BBC: April 2014

The BBC answered over **17,000** complaints from the audience during April 2014. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

There were contacts from viewers complaining they found it difficult to hear the dialogue during Jamaica Inn.

Some viewers felt there was too much news coverage of David Moyes leaving Manchester United.

There were further complaints from some viewers as Oscar Pistorius took to the witness stand that there was too much coverage of his trial.
