Complaints to the BBC: August 2012

The BBC answered over **22,000** complaints from the audience during August 2012. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

The coverage of the Olympics 2012 continued to attract complaints regarding a range of detailed issues, including relative coverage and scheduling of different sports. We also received complaints from viewers who were unhappy that an interview was conducted during the Kenyan national anthem.

The new comedy *Citizen Kahn* attracted complaints from some viewers who were unhappy with aspects of its portrayal of the Muslim community.
