

Complaints to the BBC: December 2015

The BBC answered just under **15,700** complaints from the audience during December 2015. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints from people who were unhappy that Tyson Fury was shortlisted for the BBC Sports Personality of the Year award.

There were also complaints following BBC Sport's announcement that the BBC would no longer hold the rights to televise coverage of Formula One from next season.

Finally, there were complaints from viewers who felt it was inappropriate for BBC News to report from inside the home of the suspects in the recent shootings in San Bernadino.
