Complaints to the BBC: July 2012

The BBC answered over **25,000** complaints from the audience during July 2012. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

The coverage of the Olympics 2012 attracted complaints regarding a range of detailed issues, including relative coverage and scheduling of different sports. We also received complaints from those disappointed with what they felt was too much commentary during the Opening Ceremony.

We received complaints about the BBC Sport website from people who felt that the country profiles on the Olympics page for the Israeli and Palestinian teams were inaccurate.

Finally, some listeners complained to us disappointed that Chris Moyles was to leave as presenter of the BBC Radio 1 Breakfast Show.
