Complaints to the BBC: June 2013

The BBC answered just over **15,000** complaints from the audience during June 2013. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

This month there were complaints about an edition of Sunday Politics from viewers who felt an interview with a representative of the English Defence League was too robust.

There were also some complaints from viewers of The Voice who felt that an outfit worn by one of the programme's presenters was too revealing.

Disruption to the BBC One schedule caused by a Confederations Cup match going to extra time and then penalties on 27 June also caused some complaints.

Finally, complaints were also received from viewers who felt Russell Brand was an inappropriate choice of guest during the newspaper review section of The Andrew Marr Show
