BBC Complaints to the BBC: March 2016

The BBC answered just over 18,000 complaints from the audience during March 2016. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

This month included complaints about the forthcoming series of Top Gear, following reports in the press suggesting the team filmed a stunt close to the Cenotaph.

Aspects of the commentary and presenting during this year's coverage of The Boat Races also generated complaints.
