Complaints to the BBC: May 2015

The BBC answered just over **16,500** complaints from the audience during May 2015. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised included the amount of coverage devoted to anti-austerity protests in London on Sunday, 6 May from viewers and listeners who felt it was insufficient.

We also received complaints from people who felt there was too much coverage of the birth of Princess Charlotte of Cambridge.
