

Complaints to the BBC: November 2012

The BBC answered approximately **18,600** complaints from the audience during November 2012. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

There were complaints about the announcement that Danny Baker will be leaving his afternoon show on BBC London.

We also received complaints from some viewers who felt the audience were too loud during a singer's performance on Strictly Come Dancing: the Results on 4th November.

There were complaints about the BBC's former director-general receiving a year's salary on his resignation.

Finally, we received a variety of complaints alleging pro-Palestinian or pro-Israeli bias in some reports about the Middle-East conflict.
