

Complaints to the BBC: September 2015

The BBC answered over **17,000** complaints from the audience during September 2015. These ranged from a small number of complaints about alleged breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

Topics raised this month included complaints about the 11 September edition of Newsnight from viewers who felt an interview with Daniel Kawczynski was too robust.

There were also complaints about the 5 September edition of Stephen Nolan's Radio 5 Live programme from listeners who felt a phone-in discussion on migration was poorly handled.
